Leadership Washington County (LWC) leadership development program has been strengthening the fabric of our community since 1998, and focuses its efforts in three primary areas:

Building business leaders

Building community leaders

Building professional networks

This three tier approach makes LWC unique among leadership development programs. It focuses on individual development to enhance leadership at work; it inspires participants to be leaders in our community, and it broadens professional networks to expand and create business opportunities.

LWC Participants are recruited and selected from both public and private sector businesses operating within the greater Washington County area. Each class has a rich diversity of participants, those from large companies, small companies, nonprofit businesses, government entities and sales and service operations. LWC has graduated over 230 leaders from the greater Washington County community. Our alumni are represented among the leadership of Washington County area businesses, and 75% of them sit on nonprofit and government boards of directors.

The LWC Curriculum leverages strengths-based learning through Gallup's StrengthsFinders. In each session, participants learn leadership skills that directly relate to their vocation, their position, and their personal style. StrengthsFinders discussions are woven into every LWC session.

Each session from September through May is held at a different location throughout the greater Washington County area. While engaged in leadership development, participants also learn the history and geography of our county, as well as how its systems make our county thrive. Sessions are held at our historic Washington County Courthouse, W & J College, Pony Baseball, Monongahela Valley Hospital as well as a variety of other county locations.

The capstone of the program is a Community Class Project that ultimately benefits Washington County area nonprofit organizations. Past classes have: facilitated a Youth Leadership Conference that focused on leadership skill development for area high school students; partnered with the Women & Girls Foundation to conduct an analysis of the public and private board demographics in Washington County; introduced a domestic violence curriculum, *Coaching Boys into Men*, in local high schools. Most recently, the 2015 LWC class worked with the Greater Washington County Food Bank to support their efforts in raising awareness and collecting donations for food insecure families in our region. The class was responsible for planning and implementing various events to raise money and collect food donations for the food Bank. The class worked with organization such as the Washington Wild Things, the Washington Chamber of Commerce and Off the Wall Arts to promote the mission and raise funds.
